



CO2 and Volume Estimates







When compostable or recyclable materials end up in the landfill, and new materials are made in their place, it creates CO2 and other greenhouses gasses including Methane (a greenhouse gas 30x as potent as CO2.

By recycling and composting at your event, you kept potent greenhouses gasses from entering the atmosphere.


This is measured in MTCO2E (Metric Tons of CO2 Equivalent). We've converted that into lbs. below:

Compostable cups at the finish line allowed us to divert a significant amount of waste from the landfill.

A water refill station helped reduce overall plastic waste. We were unable to reach out to the water company to get total gallons, but we estimate at least 75 lbs of plastic was eliminated.

We did not use the second trash dumpster. You could possibly save money on purchasing only 1 30-yard for this event.

There is a company that recycles granola wrappers for a small fee. If your team is interested we could reach out and start a pilot a project to divert cliff bar wrappers from the waste stream.
